

Annual Report July 2022-June 2023



Highlights

In September 2022, the library began opening on Mondays again. Mondays were eliminated from the library's schedule in the summer of 2009 as a cost-cutting measure. Further reductions in hours were necessary until the library was open just 31 hours per week from 2014—early 2019. After voters passed a 1 mill, 10-year library millage in August 2018, the library was able to start restoring service hours.





Wayne Seed Library

- Launched the Wayne Seed Library, which allows patrons to "borrow" seeds for planting at no cost. From March—June 2023, 110 people signed up for the seed library and borrowed over 1,400 packets of seeds!
- Welcomed new Library Board Trustee Emily Kliemann, who was appointed to the Board when Nancy Chiasson retired after many years of service.
- Circulated an all-time record high number of digital items through Libby and hoopla (8,535)!





Participation in the library's Summer Reading Program increased by 66% in 2023, to 318 people. This is the highest level of Summer Reading participation in the last five years, even exceeding the pre-COVID levels of 2019.
